- Artist will be chosen no later than August 6th

## *Selection Process:*

- Multiple Live Artist will be chosen
- Selected by the Festival Art Committee
- Judged by reviewing and ranking art proposals
- Judged on:

30% Art, 30% Appropriateness for HF, 20% Ability to implement and 20% Sponsorship Cost

## *Harvest Fest will provide:*

- Sponsorship money towards the costs of painting materials & Supplies
- Festival credentials for Artist
- A contact from the Festival Art Committee to assist with any needs
- A select space on the 'Magic Bus'
- A featured spotlight on all platforms bringing more opportunity to expose yourself as an artist

## *Timeline*

Submissions will be accepted for review May 1st – July 31, 2021. Final projects will be selected and announced in August 2021.

## *Rules*

- The project will require you to meet deadlines.
- Your art must be a piece created specifically for Harvest Fest, that debuts for the first time at Harvest.
- The art piece may not feature foul language, explicit images, any political or religious references, or any dangerous or derogatory aspects.
- The art must stay within the theme and color scheme
- Please ensure that you will be professional and committed to meeting all requirements.
